 - She is a lab instructor for many Civil and Geo labs, and gave students the ability to learn through hands-on labs, friendly instruction, and an openness to questions!

- Met with WatPD
 - They're looking at including more reflective questions at the end of PD courses
 - These questions would allow students to look at personal and professional goals
 - They also want to help students make better decisions on which PD courses to take - might add a question for that in the mandatory courses

- They added some new scholarships!

- Met with the Academic Reps about common issues and feedback methods
 - Common issues included:
 - Lack of training for first time profs (how to use learn, clear lectures, good exam formats)
 - Lack of rubric/guidelines for course projects or lab reports
 - An "it be like that" mentality, where because something was tough on upper years, it should continue to be a problem
 - Lack of communication between profs in a chain of courses (ie, Calc 1 might have missed a lecture, but Calc 2 prof didn't know)
 - Lack of time to find FYDP groups with similar interests not just friends
